- Install and update anti-virus, anti-spam and security software.
- Beware of downloading free software.
- If you don't know the source of an email, don't open it. Delete it.
- To help protect your identity and privacy, choose a password made of random numbers and letters.
- Only share credit card and personal information when buying from an established company.
- Do not answer pop-up messages or emails that ask you to update your account information.
- Do not cut and paste into your browser a web address that is located in the body of an unfamiliar email.
- Never pay for a "free" gift.

The Internet is a tool that can simplify and improve our lives. However, everyone should be aware of potential threats like identity theft and scams.
